In Memory of Martin Frigo, RPP

We are deeply saddened to learn of the sudden death of Martin Frigo, RPP at his home in St. Albert on Sunday, October 27, 2024. Martin worked in the planning field for over 20 years, most of his time in Alberta. Martin moved to Fort McMurray from Manitoba where he worked for the Regional Municipality of Wood Buffalo planning department. After meeting the love of his life, Beth in Fort McMurray, he moved to St. Albert and started work at the City of St. Albert, Parkland County and, more recently, the City of Edmonton.
